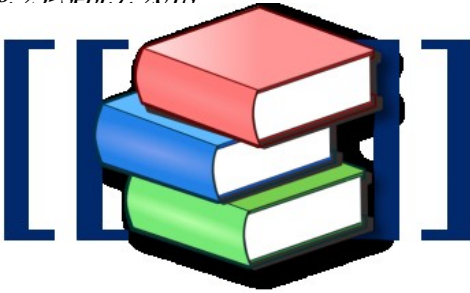

Augustine of Hippo, Sermons to the People, by William Griffin:

In a sermon titled “at the End as at The Beginning – Scriptures” Augustine of Hippo said, “there are hidden treasures among the Mysteries of God, but they have to be flushed out.” And that is exactly what William Griffin does in his translation of twenty-three of Augustine’s sermons; he flushes out the mysteries with the “soul of a poet and the training of a scholar”. Griffin gives concrete examples of why he uses “paraphrase translation” to bring these sermons into English Brilliant! Griffin takes the reader back to 391 AD (1,627 years ago) when Augustine was the “best show in town” who entertained with all the linguist entertainment that Pagans thought was theirs alone. He not only entertains, he instructs and carries on “sidebars” with “hecklers and jecklers”.

Subtlety and clarity were the two rhetorical virtues Augustine used to keep his parishioners from dozing off during his Sermons. William Griffin author of Augustine of Hippo, Sermons to the People brings the messages found in these sermons alive in an easy to read manner. And remember Augustine spoke with “NO NOTES – NO PREPARED TEXT” and he was never at a loss for words. How do we know this if Augustine had no prepared text: To find out, you will have to read this treasure which is found in our library. Enjoy!

Tax-Free IRA Charitable Gifting

Did you know that federal law allows tax-free charitable contributions of up to \$100,000 directly from your IRA?

To make a tax-free charitable contribution the following requirements must be met:

- The IRA owner must be 70 ½ or older.
- Qualified charitable contributions must be made by **DECEMBER 31st** each year.
- The charitable contribution must be transferred directly from the IRA to the eligible charity.
- A charity must be a 501 C (3) organization.
- Distribution can be made to multiple charities in the same year following the requirements.

Making a qualified charitable contribution as opposed to a normal charitable gift has two main advantages:

- A qualified charitable contribution counts toward satisfying the donor's required minimum distribution for the tax year.
- The distribution is excluded from the taxpayer's income; you do not need to itemize your taxes in order to make an IRA charitable distribution.

The Fifteen Promises of Mary

Granted to those who Recite the Rosary.

- Whosoever shall faithfully serve me by the recitation of the rosary shall receive signal graces.
 - I promise My special protection and the greatest graces to all those who shall recite the rosary.
 - The Rosary shall be a powerful armor against Hell, it will destroy vice, decrease sin, and defeat heresies.
 - It will cause good works to flourish; it will obtain for souls the abundant mercy of God; it will withdraw the hearts of men (and Women) from the love of the world and its vanities, and will lift them to the desire for eternal things. Oh, that souls would sanctify themselves by this means.
 - The soul which recommends itself to me by the recitation of the Rosary shall not perish.
 - Whosoever shall recite the rosary devoutly applying himself (herself) to the consideration of its sacred mysteries shall never be conquered by misfortune. God will not chastise him in His justice, he shall not perish by an unprovoked death; if he be just he shall remain in the Grace of God and become worthy of eternal life.
- Whoever shall have a true devotion for the rosary shall not die without the Sacraments of the Church.
